



Becoming an Outdoors Woman Hunting 101 Workshop and Hunter Education Field Day Saturday, July 13, 2024

If you have an interest in hunting but don't know where to start, this course is for you!

This class will begin with the Field Day Workshop portion of the Maryland Hunter Education Internet Class. Participants must complete the online portion of the class prior to attending and must present their completion voucher when they arrive. The online portion of the class costs \$24.95 to take but the classroom portion is free. The class will include a short review, a live fire activity with pellet rifles, a woods walk with shoot or don't shoot demonstrations, and a 50 question exam. Upon successful completion, participants will receive their Hunter Education Certification (needed prior to purchasing a hunting license).

The afternoon portion of this class will include instruction and discussion on topics pertaining to getting started hunting in Maryland. This will include an introduction to Maryland hunting laws and regulations, hunting gear available for various game species, and public hunting land access and etiquette.
