

# Chronology of Speeches

Theodore Roosevelt was clearly among the most prolific speakers in American public life. The following chronology of speeches has been collated from a wide variety of sources. Nevertheless, given the often spontaneous nature of his remarks, especially during his campaigns, it is a virtually impossible task to produce a complete chronology. As indicated earlier in this volume, Roosevelt prepared most of his addresses in advance, typically delivering them from a manuscript, though utilizing that manuscript far less than most manuscript speakers. Consequently, a large number of Roosevelt speeches are available to the researcher.

Three principal sources of Roosevelt's speeches exist. While many anthologies of his speeches were published, clearly the most extensive published speech collection can be found in The Works of Theodore Roosevelt. This is the most readily available comprehensive collection of Roosevelt speeches and includes virtually all of the speeches commonly associated with Roosevelt and extensive samples of his speaking drawn from each major period of his life.

The Roosevelt papers held by the Library of Congress provide the researcher with a wealth of Roosevelt speech material. Significantly, many of the speeches held in the Library of Congress collection also include one or more of the earlier drafts, as well as the final speech manuscript that was delivered. The Library of Congress collection of Roosevelt's speeches are almost all from his presidential years.

The final major collection of Roosevelt speeches can be found among the holdings of the Theodore Roosevelt collection at Harvard University. The heart of this collection is the library of the Roosevelt Memorial Association, which was donated to Harvard and to which Harvard has steadily added. Volume five

of the Theodore Roosevelt Collection Dictionary Catalogue and Shelflist, which indexes the entire collection, concludes with a sixty-page listing of the speeches, excerpts from speeches, or references to speeches, found in the collection. Essentially, these are all published works, but many are from campaign documents, rare magazines, newspapers, privately printed documents, and similar difficult-to-obtain material.
