## **Chapter 12 Little Annemessex River**

Authority: Natural Resources Article, §§8-703 and 8-704, Annotated Code of Maryland

### .01 Little Annemessex River.

The Little Annemessex River encompasses all the waters of Little Annemessex River and its tributaries, except Broad Creek and Daugherty Canal, easterly of a line [from Lat. 37°58'28.99"N., Long. 75°53'55.12"W. (Island Point), and running 161° True to the opposite shore, Lat. 37°57'22.33"N., Long. 75°53'26.12"W. (Great Point).] beginning at Island Point at or near Lat. 37° 58.483' N., Long. 75° 53.917' W., then running 161° (True) to Great Point, at or near Lat. 37° 57.367' N., Long. 75° 53.433' W.

#### .02 Crisfield Harbor.

Crisfield Harbor encompasses the area beginning at a point [Lat. 37°58'38.36"N., Long. 75°51'51.13"W., a line running 160° True to the opposite shore, Lat. 37°58'33.43"N., Long. 75°51'48.86"W.,] at or near Lat. 37°58.637' N., Long. 75°51.858' W., then running 168° (True) to a point, at or near Lat. 37°58.547' N., Long. 75°51.835' W., and running to the head of the harbor. This area has a 6-knot [(6.9 MPH)] speed limit all year.

#### .03 Daugherty Creek Canal — Janes Island State Park Harbor.

The Daugherty Creek Canal—Janes Island State Park Harbor encompasses the area beginning at a point on the north side of the east end of Ward Creek, [Lat. 38°00'36.4"N., Long. 75°50'57.5"W., running 195° True to the south side of the east end of Ward Creek, Lat. 38°00'34.5"N., Long. 75°50'58.2"W., and upstream of a point on the east side of Daugherty Creek Canal, Lat. 38°00'31"N., Long. 75°50'56.6"W., and running 281° True to the west side of Daugherty Creek Canal, Lat. 38°00'31.4"N., Long. 75°50'59"W., and south (downstream) of a point at Lat. 38°00'40.2"N., Long. 75°50'53.7"W., running 282° True to the west side of Daugherty Creek Canal, Lat. 38°00'40.6"N., Long. 75°50'55.9"W.] at or near Lat. 38° 0.607' N., Long. 75° 50.958' W., then running 196° (True) to the south side of Ward Creek, at or near Lat. 38° 0.575' N., Long. 75° 50.970' W., and north (upstream) of a point on the east side of Daughtery Creek Canal, at or near Lat. 38° 0.517' N., Long. 75° 50.943' W., then running 282° (True) to the west side of Daughtery Creek Canal, at or near Lat. 38° 0.523' N., Long. 75° 50.983' W., and south (downstream) of a point on the east side of the Daughterty Creek Canal, at or near Lat. 38° 0.670' N., Long. 75° 50.895' W., then running 283° (True) to a point, at or near Lat. 38° 0.677' N., Long. 75° 50.932' W. This area has a 6-knot [(6.9 mph)] speed limit all year.

## .04 Janes Island State Park Water Trails.

A. All of the waters of [The] the Blue Trail south of a line beginning at a point [Lat. 38°00'39.2"N., Long. 75°51'37.7"W., running 163° True to a point Lat. 38°00'36.9"N., Long. 75°51'36.9"W., and north of a line beginning at Lat. 38°00'3.2"N., Long. 75°51'36.5"W., and running 249° True to a point at Lat. 38°00'2.0"N., Long. 75°51'40.5"W.] at or near Lat. 38° 0.653′ N., Long. 75°51.628′ W., then running 165° (True) to a point, at or near Lat. 38° 0.615′ N., Long. 75°51.615′ W., and north of a line beginning at a point, at or near Lat. 38° 0.053′ N., Long. 75°51.608′ W., then running 249° (True) to a point, at or near Lat. 38° 0.033′ N., Long. 75°51.675′ W. Personal watercraft (PWC) may not operate in excess of idle speed in this area [at all times] all year.

B. All of the waters of [The] the Black Trail north of a line beginning at a point [Lat. 37°59'53.5"N., Long. 75°52'10.5"W., and running 341° True to a point Lat. 37°59'54.8"N., Long. 75°52'11.1"W., and south of a line beginning at a point Lat. 38°00'42.7"N., Long. 75°52'11.8"W., and running 121° True to a point at Lat. 38°00'41"N., Long. 75°52'8.4"W.] at or near Lat. 37° 59.892' N., Long. 75° 52.175' W., then running 340° (True) to a point, at or near Lat. 37° 59.913' N., Long. 75° 52.185' W., and south of a line beginning at a point at or near Lat. 38° 0.712' N., Long. 75° 52.197' W., then running 122° (True) to a point, at or near Lat. 38° 0.683' N., Long. 75° 52.140' W. Personal watercraft (PWC) may not operate in excess of idle speed in this area [at all times] all year.

C. All of the waters of [The] the Red Trail north of a line beginning at a point [Lat. 38°01'5.2"N., Long. 75°51'59.8"W., and running 148° True to a point Lat. 38°01'2.9"N., Long. 75°51'58"W., and south of a line beginning at a point Lat. 38°01'27.6"N., Long. 75°51'4.4"W., and running 13° True to a point Lat. 38°01'30.4"N., Long. 75°51'3.5"W.]at or near Lat. 38° 1.087' N., Long. 75° 51.997' W., then running 148° (True) to a point, at or near Lat. 38° 1.048' N., Long. 75° 51.967' W., and south of a line beginning at a point at or near Lat. 38° 1.460' N., Long. 75° 51.073' W., then running 14° (True) to a point, at or near Lat. 38° 1.507' N., Long. 75° 51.058' W. Personal watercraft (PWC) may not operate in excess of idle speed in this area [at all times] all year.
