## . 01 Nanticoke River.

The Nanticoke River encompasses all the waters of the Nanticoke River and its tributaries north[erly of a line from Lat. $38^{\circ} 13^{\prime} 56.69^{\prime \prime N}$., Long. $75^{\circ} 58^{\prime} 18.68^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W} .$, running $095^{\circ}$ True to the opposite shore, Lat. $38^{\circ} 13^{\prime} 38.03$ "N., Long. $75^{\circ} 53^{\prime} 31.03^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$.] of a line beginning at a point at or near Lat. $38^{\circ} 13.950^{\prime}$ N., Long. $75^{\circ} 58.317^{\prime}$ W., then running $95^{\circ}$ (True) to a point, at or near Lat. $38^{\circ} 13.633^{\prime}$ N., Long. $75^{\circ} 53.517^{\prime} \mathrm{W}$.

## . 02 Marshyhope Creek.

A. Lower Marshyhope Creek encompasses the area beginning at a point [Lat. 38³9'37.14"N., Long. $75^{\circ} 47^{\prime} 34.25^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$., a line running $180^{\circ}$ True to the opposite shore Lat. $38^{\circ} 39^{\prime} 33.78^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{N}$. , Long. $75^{\circ} 47^{\prime} 34.25^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$., and running north upstream to a line beginning at a point Lat. $38^{\circ} 40^{\prime} 34^{\prime \prime N}$., Long. $75^{\circ} 46^{\prime} 28^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$., a line running $100^{\circ}$ True to the opposite shore Lat. $38^{\circ} 40$ '33 N., Long. $75^{\circ} 46^{\prime} 26^{\prime \prime W}$ W.] at or near Lat. $38^{\circ} 39.680^{\prime}$ N., Long. $75^{\circ} 47.815^{\prime}$ W., then running $147^{\circ}$ (True) to a point, at or near Lat. $38^{\circ} 39.653^{\prime}$ N., Long. $75^{\circ} 47.793^{\prime}$ W., then running $99^{\circ}$ (True) to a point, at or near Lat. $38^{\circ} 39.625^{\prime}$ N., Long. $75^{\circ} 47.570^{\prime}$ W., then running $180^{\circ}$ (True) to a point, at or near Lat. $38^{\circ}$ $39.577^{\prime}$ N., Long. $75^{\circ} 47.570^{\prime}$ W. This area has a minimum wake zone from March 1 through June 15 [each year].
B. Upper Marshyhope Creek encompasses the area beginning at a point [Lat. $38^{\circ} 40^{\prime} 34^{\prime \prime}$ N., Long. $75^{\circ} 46^{\prime} 28^{\prime \prime}$ W., a line running $100^{\circ}$ True to the opposite shore Lat. $38^{\circ} 40^{\prime} 33^{\prime \prime N}$., Long. $75^{\circ} 46^{\prime} 26^{\prime \prime W}$., ]at or near Lat. $38^{\circ} 39.625^{\prime} \mathrm{N}$., Long. $75^{\circ} 47.570^{\prime}$ W., then running $180^{\circ}$ (True) to a point, at or near Lat. $38^{\circ} 39.577^{\prime} N$., Long. $75^{\circ} 47.570^{\prime}$ W., and running to the head of the creek. This area has a minimum wake zone all year.
