Chapter 17 Northeast River

Authority: Natural Resources Article, §§8-703 and 8-704, Annotated Code of Maryland

.01 Northeast River.

The Northeast River encompasses all the waters of the Northeast River and its tributaries northeasterly of a line [from Lat. 39°2'21.28"N., Long. 76°0'42.11"W., running 115° True to the opposite shore, Lat. 39°1'40.92"N., Long. 75°8'50.34"W.]beginning at a point at or near Lat. 39° 32.350' N., Long. 76°0.700' W., then running 115° (True) to a point, at or near Lat. 39° 31.683' N., Long. 75° 58.833' W.

.02 Upper Northeast River.

The Upper Northeast River encompasses the area beginning at a point [Lat. 39°35'29.42"N., Long. 75°57'06.51"W., a line running 145° True to the opposite shore, Lat. 39°35'16.73"N., Long. 75°56'55.02"W.,]at or near Lat. 39° 35.605' N., Long. 75° 57.067' W., then running 165° (True) to a point, at or near Lat. 39° 35.250' N., Long. 75° 56.945' W., and running to the head of the river. This area has a 6-knot [(6.9 MPH)] speed limit all year.
