
RESULTS

In 2019, anglers reported data from 106 striped bass trips through the Volunteer Angler Survey. Thank you for your continued participation!

Lengths of striped bass reported in 2019



477 striped bass lengths were reported in 2019:

- 28% were harvested (average length 23.5 inches)
- 72% were released (average length 17.8 inches)
