

2018 Volunteer Fire Assistance Grants Announced

49 Volunteer Fire Departments in 17 Counties to Receive \$104,099 in Grant Funding

The Maryland Department of Natural Resources Forest Service announced the 2018 Volunteer Fire Assistance (VFA) grants to 49 volunteer fire departments across the state. The projects are to be funded in 17 Maryland counties to assist volunteer fire companies to enhance wildland fire protection in rural communities.

This year 60 Volunteer Fire Departments from 19 counties applied for funding assistance with \$310,388 in projects. The Maryland Forest Service awarded grant funds to 49 fire departments for \$104,099 in match funding to complete \$245,907 in total project cost. The maximum grant awarded was \$3,000 per department. The Federal Grant funds are provided by the USDA Forest Service.
