Minutes of the Garrett County Forest Conservancy District Board Meeting December 11, 2023

Call To Order:

The Garrett County Forestry Board met at 9:00 a.m. on Monday December 11, 2023 at Perkins Restaurant. OLD BUSINESS:

Watershed

The watershed coordinator position has been advertised again and shared with the college and other possible sources of applicants.

Dredging at Arrowhead Cove is ongoing. The county will be contacting landowners about projects to reduce sediment & working on the stream assessment. A Brunch & Learn update will be held Dec 14th.

Big Tree Calendar

Melissa shared proposed monthly photos and suggested 1 tree per month along with information about the species/specific tree along with coordinates for publicly accessible trees. Will made a motion, 2nd by John to proceed with that format. The motion passed. Melissa and Siera will work on a layout.

Garrett College Trivia

The event was very well attended. Mike K. and Melissa participated. Proceeds from the fundraiser benefit a student trip to Costa Rica to learn about exotic wildlife and habitats. John made a motion to donate \$1,000 to the students from the Board. Fred 2nd. Discussion included unknown total cost/need. John withdrew his motion until Melissa could find more information.

Melissa received a response during the meeting and shared that 8 students planned to attend at a cost of \$1,800-2,000 each. After fundraising, remaining expenses are out of pocket for the students. John reintroduced his motion to donate \$1,000 and Larry 2nd. The motion passed.

BBD/BLD Webinar

Beech leaf disease has been observed in many MD counties now, including Garrett. The webinar was recorded.

Yough River

John reported we are still waiting on the judicial review. He would also like to see the local advisory board meet on a more regular basis with a mandated frequency. They will meet Monday Dec 18th.

This program primarily applies further east. Garrett and Allegany counties utilize the Western MD RC&D tree planting grant. Approximately 107 acres of planting projects will be submitted for Garrett County to be planted in 2026.

County Budget
