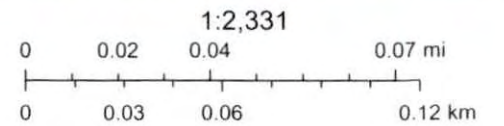

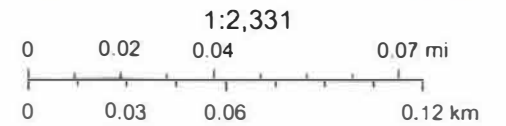


2 ACM Baseball Field

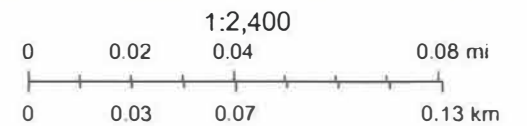


3 Cresaptown Sports Complex

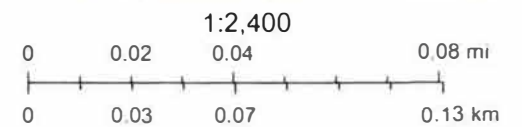


4 Glendening Recreation Complex

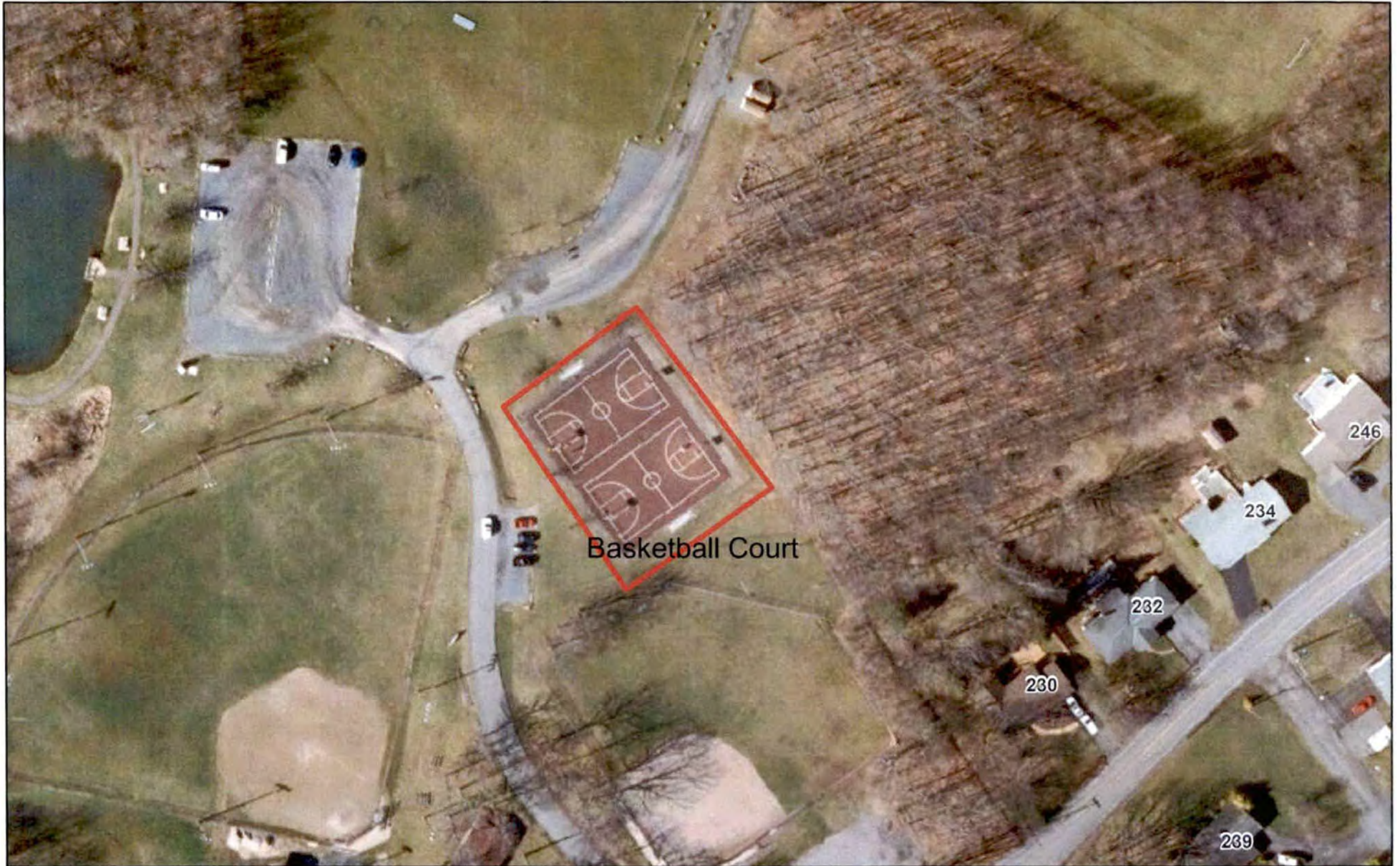

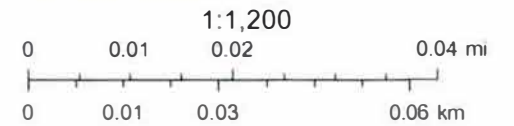

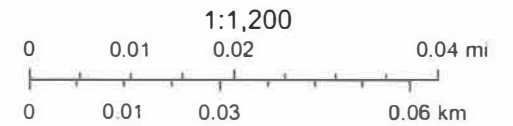

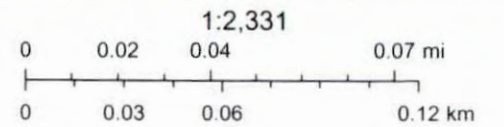

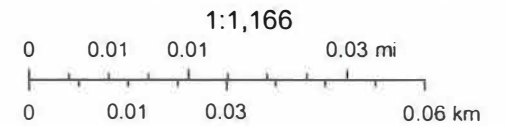


6 Luke Legacy Park

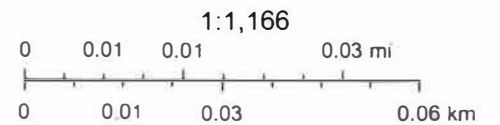
7 Pratt Street Park

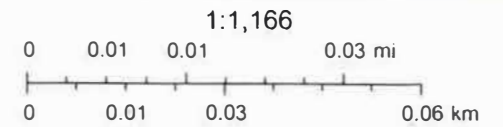


8 Maryland Ave Playground

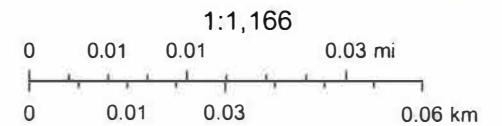


9 Maryland Ave Ballfields

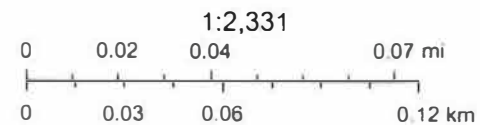


10 Meadow Park

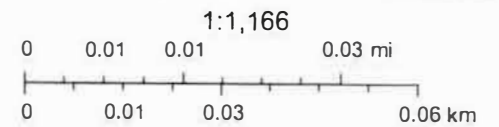


11 Oldtown Ballfield

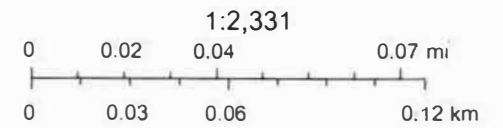

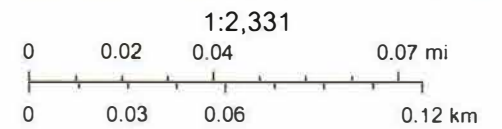


14 Gene Mason Rec. Complex

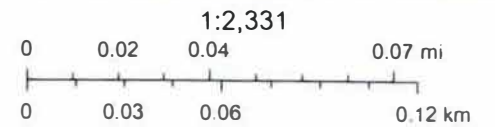
15 Miner's Memorial Park

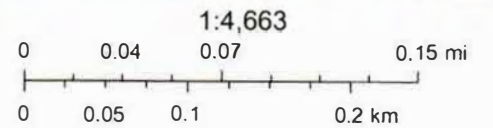


16 Bel Air Rec. Complex

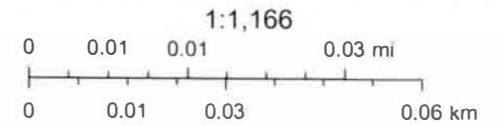
17 Frostburg Depot
