NEW HOPE Nature ACADEMY: Playground

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
DESIGN GOALS

To address the concerns and wants of the students, faculty, staff and parents of the New Hope Academy alike. This space has been designed to accomodate seating areas and shade for teachers, parents or older students in addition to the prescribed Nature Playground areas for the younger students. Inspiration came partly from an overwhelmingly positive response on the students' parts to water features in their favorite landscapes, thus the inclusion of a stormwater catchment system and rain garden that would also address the erosion and runoff issues on the site.


