

2023-2024 BOW HUNTING AT CYPRESS BRANCH STATE PARK

Cypress Branch State Park is a 314-acre park in Millington, Maryland, of which 75 acres is designated for white-tailed deer hunting.

A total of SIX (6) bow hunters are permitted each day – THREE (3) in the morning and THREE (3) in the afternoon - on a *first-come, first-served* basis during the season as specified in the *2023-2024 Maryland Guide to Hunting and Trapping*. Hunting is allowed Monday thru Saturday in the designated hunting area only, one (1) hour before sunrise until one (1) hour after sunset. If you arrive to hunt and the maximum number of hunters are signed in, you must wait until one person exits before you enter the hunting area.

The map on the reverse outlines the approximate boundaries of the hunting area. It is important to note that hunting is not permitted within 150 yards of a dwelling, public road or adjacent property line. Please respect these safety zones. When crossing fields, hunters should take care to avoid damaging crops.

A sign-up sheet will be available at the designated parking lot and hunters must sign-in AND out before leaving the area. When the sign-up sheet is full, hunters will be encouraged to visit nearby Millington Wildlife Management Area (WMA).

Hunting is prohibited on Sundays.
