

Letterboxing Clue - Growing Wild!

You will need to use a map of the Soldiers Delight Natural Environment Area. Maps are available in the visitor center, on the bulletin board in the visitor center parking lot, and in the Overlook parking lot.

IMPORTANT:

You will be walking in living grassland. Stay on the trail!

Plants grow by the inch and die by the foot.

Please keep in mind that Soldiers Delight NEA is home to many rare and endangered plant species and their lives depend on our decisions.

Wildflower Letterbox (approximately 1.2 miles round trip)

Soldiers Delight is a work in progress to provide the right habitat for nearly 40 rare, threatened, and endangered plants. Restoration work is done largely by volunteers who cut down invasive plants and help with prescribed burns. You will see many different stages of the restoration process on this hike. To get to this letterbox you must go to where Yellow, Red, and Orange meet. There you will find three signs and a post with the number 3 on it. To find the location of this letterbox you must look on the back of the signs and post. Start by facing the # 3 post - go clockwise and look at the back of the signs to fill in the blanks. End at the # 3 post for the last but very important clue. Don't forget to write it down.

To find this letterbox **go** to the Blue _____ house by _____ Dog.
