TRAVEL TO AND PARKING FOR MANTA NOON SEMINARS AT MARYLAND DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES, TAWES BUILDING, 580 TAYLOR AVENUE, ANNAPOLIS

To get into the gated state employee parking lot next to the Navy-Marine Corps Stadium (no parking fee), turn right off Taylor Avenue at the **Gate 6** entrance to the stadium lot (second entrance to that parking lot, third right after turning onto Taylor Avenue from Rowe Blvd.). Approach the gate at the top of the hill and push the gray button on the intercom. <u>Hold the</u> <u>button down while you speak</u>. Give the responding attendant your name and state that you are attending the MANTA Noon Seminar at DNR in the Tawes Building. The gate will be raised for you. Park anywhere up there you can find a spot. Walk down the hill and cross Taylor Avenue, enter the Tawes Building at the revolving door, sign in at the security guard's desk, and pickup your temporary visitor's pass. You'll need to show your driver's license. The C-1 Conference Room is just off the left side of the lobby across from the aquaria.
